1. The name of the Society is Pacific Centre Family Services Association
2. Purposes:
 - a. To establish, own, control and operate centres for well-being, mental health and healthcare that provide assessment, diagnosis, treatment, counselling, recreation, education, rehabilitation, and other ancillary resources and programs to individuals, families, and groups;
 - b. To carry on activities, treatments and practices intended to enhance the quality and dignity of life of individuals, families, and groups within the community, and encourage healthy patterns of living;
 - c. To apply for all lawful and necessary grants in aid;
 - d. To operate as a charitable organization to receive charitable donations towards such purposes by cash, land, real or personal property or otherwise;
 - e. To purchase, take on lease, hire or otherwise acquire and hold lands or buildings or any interest therein for the purpose of establishing and operating well-being, mental health and healthcare centres that provide assessment, diagnosis, treatment, counselling, recreation, education, rehabilitation, and other ancillary resources and programs to individuals, families and groups.
